

FORM OF APPOINTMENT OF PROXY

Rule 33 Appointment of proxies

- (1) Each member is to be entitled to appoint another member as proxy by notice given to the secretary no later than 24 hours before the time of the meeting in respect of which the proxy is appointed.
- (2) The notice appointing the proxy is to be in the form set out in Appendix 2 to these rules.

Rule 32 (2) All votes must be given personally or by proxy but no member may hold more than 5 proxies.
